

# English language proficiency for non-domestic learners

When enrolling into a qualification as a non-domestic learner in New Zealand, you need to be able meet certain English Language requirements. These requirements are set by the New Zealand Qualifications Authority (NZQA). A non-domestic learner is someone working in New Zealand on a visa excluding residency visas. To enrol with us, you will need to meet the criteria in one of the following options.
